- 3. The requirements for the renewal of a Permit to Fly are contained in British Civil Airworthiness Requirements, Section A, Chapters, A3-5, A3-7 and Section B, Chapters B3-5, B3-7 and Part.21A.711 and Part.21A.723 (b).
- 4. All parts of the form should be completed.
- 5. If the aircraft has been modified in any way the Permit to Fly limitations may have to be amended, therefore all relevant documentation must be provided with this application.
- 6. If the renewal is cancelled the CAA may still have to levy a charge for any investigative or administrative work it has incurred and this may reduce the amount we can refund.
- 7. A Permit to Fly renewal will be administered as a subsequent issue of the Permit if the application meets one of the following criteria:
 - a. When the Validity has ceased to be in force for more than 12 months. In this case, details of location and storage conditions (including maintenance carried out) during this period will be required. Please record these details on Page 2 of the Form SRG 1710 (CA3) (Additional Information); or
 - b. When the aircraft has been de-registered for any purpose; or
 - c. When the Permit to Fly has previously been revoked.
